1. Read the descriptions of each service below and choose which one you're interested in (remember, everything is free and there are no extra fees):

STORYTELLING

An individual from our team will bring books of your choice or read books you already have to your kids. It's more than reading: we make it fun and interactive. Your child is our priority, so we will adjust the service however needed.

If you have specific books you would like us to read, please tell us in advance so we can acquire them.

There are two options you can choose from (or alternate between):

Online Through online meeting resources like Google Meets or Zoom, we will read the stories.	In person Depending on the location of your child (the hospital or residence), we will bring the books and read the stories with them.
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ARTS & CRAFTS

Art is fun, but it's even more exciting to do with someone! A member from our team will bring art materials and teach or simply do art with your child.

We have various options including

- Origami
- Sketching
- Painting (limited to watercolor)
- Sculpting (play-doh)
- Coloring (color pencils, crayons, markers)
- Other (an option of your choice. You can contact us and we can see if we would be able to provide that art service for you)

Remember, we will bring all materials *free of cost*. Please let us know about any sensitivities, allergies, or other behaviors that could put your child at risk. This way, we bring the safest materials so we can have the most fun.

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MUSIC

It's always fun to listen to music. But playing an instrument, singing, or listening to music with someone else makes it so much more enjoyable.

We have members who can sing, play the piano, and other instruments. Based on your child's interest, we can teach their favorite songs or sing and play for/with them.

If you have songs your child is interested in, please tell us in advance so we can practice/learn the songs, and find the materials for it.

Currently, for instruments like the piano, we are unable to provide it. If you have a piano or another instrument at your location and are comfortable with us using it, we would be happy to teach/play with your child using that instrument.

Singing is more feasible than an instrument, but we can alter our meeting plan depending on the resources (which instrument you may have) and devices you have.</p> <p>We can create a lesson for your child to learn how to sing or play an instrument. 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OTHER (YOUR CHOICE)

We can teach a variety of academic subjects (our team members are skilled as evident through their advanced classes, extracurriculars, and passions) like math, english, french, science, social studies, etc. Depending on your child's interest and pace, we will create the curriculum.

Many of our members already tutor kids online, and have extensive experience with creating a curriculum that suits your child, and creating a fun yet educational time. In person Teaching in person would be the same: we would bring the necessary materials and teach your child what they are interested in. Other ideas: depending on the request, we can see how to best do it in person.
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2. After you've chosen a service, the next step is to set up a meeting with us online. After looking through our team, you can meet with us to determine who best fits the interests of your child (This depends on the service you choose. For example, if your child is interested in learning singing, we would set you up with an individual with that skill). After meeting with the member online, the next step is to determine a timing and location. Depending on the regulations and limitations of your hospital, we can see if an in person meeting is feasible. If not, as described above, online options for all services are available.
